

- **US Dept. of Justice - Office of Justice Programs:** Grantees may utilize Recovery Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) funds for state and local initiatives, technical assistance, training, personnel, equipment, supplies, contractual support, and information systems for criminal justice, as well as research and evaluation activities that will improve or enhance law enforcement programs related to criminal justice. Examples include programs in: prosecution and court; prevention and education; corrections and community corrections; drug treatment and enforcement; planning, evaluation, and technology improvement; and crime victim and witness (other than compensation). The application deadline is June 17, 2009.
- **Administration for Children and Families:** States may use Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program funds carried over from a prior year for any allowable TANF benefit, service or activity. Previously these funds could be used only to provide assistance. This interim final rule applies to States, local governments, and Tribes that administer the TANF program. Effective Date: May 27, 2009. Comments are due on or before July 27, 2009.
- **Corporation for National and Community Service:** \$8 million in funds to support national providers of training and technical assistance for community service programs that use service and volunteering to meet community needs. The deadline for eGrants submissions is July 2, 2009.
